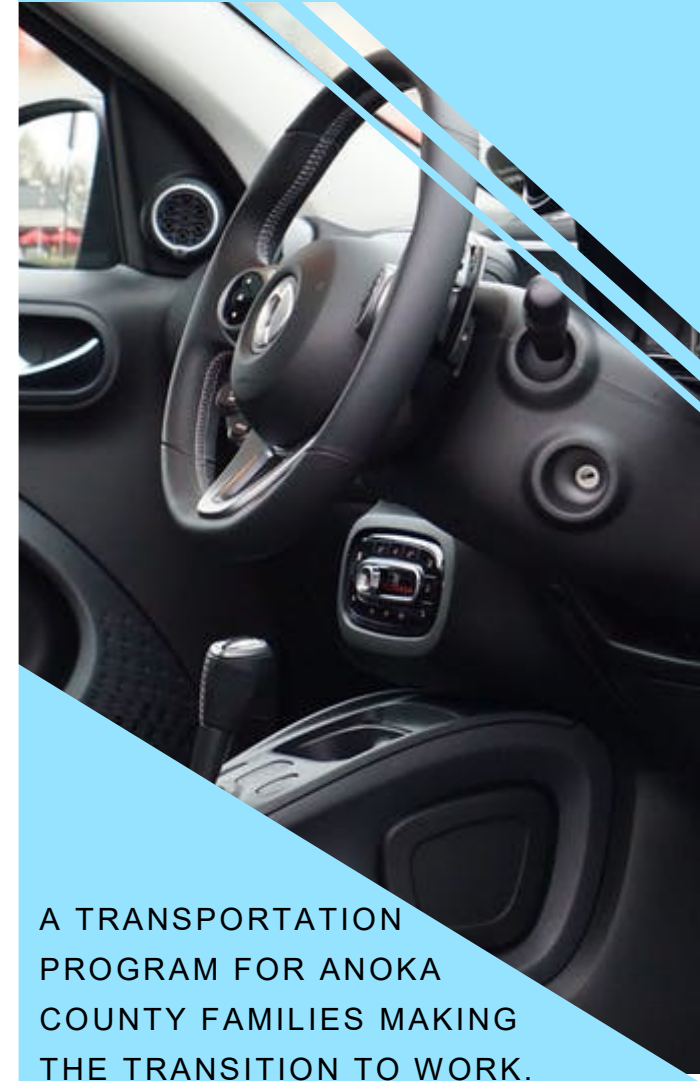

TRANSPORTATION SOLUTIONS

The Transportation Solutions program provides grants for car repair, insurance and licensing to families making the transition to work. This helps them gain reliable transportation to maintain their employment and be active in their community.

WE PROVIDE CAR REPAIR, INSURANCE & LICENSING GRANTS:

- ⇒ Grants up to \$700* are available and do not need to be paid back.
- ⇒ ALL GRANTS MUST BE PRE-APPROVED. There are NO reimbursements.

** Grants are dependent on funding availability.*

Applications for car repairs, insurance, and licensing grants are available at 2nd floor reception at the Blaine Human Service Center (1201 89th Avenue NE, Blaine) or by calling 763.324.2318.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- ◆ Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP) or Diversionary Work Program (DWP) enrolled and actively participating (including job search activities); employed full or part time or enrolled in short-term training program; or off MFIP or DWP due to over-income (up to six months after exiting MFIP or DWP).
- ◆ Must be in compliance and meet participation hour requirements for at least 30 days or verify employment.
- ◆ Valid Minnesota driver's license with current address.
- ◆ Name listed as owner on vehicle's title.
- ◆ Proof of insurance.
- ◆ To receive a grant for car insurance, you must provide a copy of your bill from your insurance company or three quotes from local insurance agencies to start a new policy.
