

Beginning **July 1, 2017**, lead teachers and providers need to have the appropriate hours of training, coaching, consultation, or mentoring in the Knowledge and Competency Framework (KCF) Content Areas outlined below. Requirements are listed by Star Rating Level. Visit ParentAware.org/programs/earn-a-rating for more information. Prepare for your Rating by doing these three things:

1) Have a Current License



Your license should be in good standing with the Minnesota Department of Human Services or your Tribal Government.

2) Be Serving Children



Your program should be actively providing child care and early education to children, ranging in age from birth to kindergarten entry.

3) Have a Develop Membership



All lead providers and teachers should have a current Individual Membership in Develop. Go to developtoolmn.org.
