**Rental Property Vacancy Listings 10/7/2021**

Rents are not based on your income. ACCAP doesn't offer regular assistance to our tenants with paying their rent. For Apartments your household must have a monthly income that equals 2-times the monthly rent; for Townhomes\* and Twin Homes monthly income requirement will be the greater of 2 ½-times the rent or 2 times the sum of the tenant rent plus utilities; and Single Family homes monthly income requirement will be the greater of 3-times the rent or 2 ½-times the sum of the tenant rent plus utilities.

\*The Blaine University Avenue Townhomes monthly income requirement is 3 times the rent.

**NOTE: Due to Covid-19, ACCAP Housing Applications cannot be picked up or dropped off at the Blaine Human Services building. The building is currently closed to the public. All applications will need to be mailed, emailed or faxed.**

Phone calls will not be returned.

Deposit is the amount of the monthly rent and is due in full at the time of lease signing in addition to first month's rent.

**\*Smoking is prohibited in our buildings, including inside individual rental units, at all ACCAP housing.  
(inside apartments and townhomes/single family homes) as of January 1, 2011 \***

**ACCAP Pet Policy:** ACCAP Housing will allow one (1) adult cat per unit or one (1) single caged bird, or one (1) fish tank that is no larger than a five (5) gallon capacity after tenants pay an additional \$300.00 pet deposit.
